

FUTURE FORMS

FUTURO con WILL (yo iré, tú serás, etc.)

- En **afirmativo** se forma poniendo el **sujeto + WILL+ Verbo en infinitivo**
They (play) in a band
They **WILL PLAY** in a band
- En **negativo** se forma poniendo el **sujeto + WON'T + Verbo en infinitivo**
They (not/play) in a band
They **WON'T PLAY** in a band
- En **interrogativo** se forma poniendo el **WILL+ sujeto + Verbo en infinitivo??**
..... (they/play) in a band ??
WILL THEY PLAY in a band ??

Affirmative		Negative		Interrogative
I	WILL go	I	WON'T be am	WILL I learn ?
You	WILL beare	you	WON'T ask	WILL you have ?
He	WILL stay	he	WON'T have	WILL he read ?
She	WILL work	she	WON'T see	WILL she pack ?
It	WILL sing	it	WON'T bring	WILL it run ?
We	WILL write	we	WON'T speak	WILL we talk ?
You	WILL open	you	WON'T listen	WILL you feel ?
They	WILL buy	they	WON'T spend	WILL they touch ?

USOS DEL FUTURO CON WILL:

1. Predicciones que expresan nuestra opinión personal

I think he ... (be) a great doctor

I think he **WILL BE** a great doctor

(Estoy expresando mi opinión con "I think")

2. Promesas

I promise, I ...(not/tell) anybody

I promise, I **won't tell** anybody

(Estoy haciendo una promesa con "I promise")

3. Decisiones espontáneas, tomadas al mismo tiempo que se habla

A: What would you like to drink, sir?

B: I tea, please

B: I **WILL HAVE** tea, please

(Acabo de decidir lo que voy a tomar)

FUTURO con BE GOING TO (yo VOY A comer, tú VAS A jugar, etc)

- En **afirmativo** se forma poniendo el **sujeto + AM/IS/ARE + GOING TO + Verbo en infinitivo**
She (study) Medicine
She **IS GOING TO STUDY** Medicine
- En **negativo** se forma poniendo el **sujeto + AM NOT /ISN' /AREN'T + GOING TO + Verbo en infinitivo**
She (not/study) Medicine
She **ISN'T GOING TO STUDY** Medicine
- En **interrogativo** se forma poniendo el **AM/IS/ARE + sujeto + GOING TO + Verbo en infinitivo**
..... (she/study) Medicine ??
IS SHE GOING TO STUDY Medicine ??

Affirmative

I	AM	GOING TO	eat
You	ARE	GOING TO	play
He	IS	GOING TO	study
She	IS	GOING TO	walk
It	IS	GOING TO	watch
We	ARE	GOING TO	drive
You	ARE	GOING TO	meet
They	ARE	GOING TO	stand

Negative

I	AM NOT	GOING TO	eat
you	AREN'T	GOING TO	play
he	ISN'T	GOING TO	study
she	ISN'T	GOING TO	walk
it	ISN'T	GOING TO	watch
we	AREN'T	GOING TO	drive
you	AREN'T	GOING TO	meet
they	AREN'T	GOING TO	stand

Interrogative

AM	I	GOING TO	eat ?
ARE	you	GOING TO	play ?
IS	he	GOING TO	study ?
IS	she	GOING TO	walk
IS	it	GOING TO	watch ?
ARE	we	GOING TO	drive ?
ARE	you	GOING TO	meet ?
ARE	they	GOING TO	stand ?

USOS DEL FUTURO CON GOING TO:

1. Planes o intenciones

Sam (open) his own shop when he finishes university

Sam **IS GOING TO OPEN** his own shop when he finishes university

(Es su plan, no sabemos si lo hará o no)

2. Hechos evidentes

(Veo a una mujer embarazada y digo)

Oh! Look! She (have) a baby

Oh! Look! She **IS GOING TO HAVE** a baby

(Por su aspecto, está claro que va a tener un bebé)
